Membership: You must be a member of British Fencing (or equivalent) to fence in this competition. You must bring your licence with you.

Referees: Clubs with 4 fencers or more **must** provide a referee, clubs with 8 or more must provide 2.

Equipment: For the U13 & U11 events (all fencers born 97 or later) you **must** use a size 2 (or smaller) sabre. The size 2 standard laid down by British Fencing is: length 815mm +/- 5mm, flexibility between 90mm & 120mm, the blade should be marked "BFA". All Leon Paul size 2 & 0 sabre blades will conform to this standard.
